BEER INFO FOR SEPTEMBER

Our 16 oz. can lineup will include:

AVENUE OF THE PINES IPA from north way brewing. It's a bold New England style IPA with combo of Galaxy, Citra, Mosaic, Amarillo, Simcoe, and Idaho-7 hops which provides tropical fruit and subtle pine flavor.

We will have Unraveled IPA from Founders. They have unraveled some favorite American hops to get to the juicy goodness inside. Dry hopped with traditional hop pellets along with lupulin powder, an innovative hop product that separates lupulin from the hop flower. Unraveled IPA is incredibly flavorful and aromatic. (From the Procurer, "A very clean not too hoppy ipa.")

And, we will have Landshark 16 oz. cans to end summer. Born in Margaritaville, this island-style lager is a complex blend of hops and two-row caramel malts with a light, refreshing taste and a hint of malty sweetness.

### KEGS:

In terms of kegs beyond our standard lineup of Coors Light, Down East Cider, and Blue Moon we will be bringing back Fiddlehead IPA.

In our rotation of kegs, we be adding Bolton Landing Brewing's Pinnacle Sunrise Pilsner, a very crisp, light, and refreshing beer. A departure from our usual IPAs, we hope you like it.

We will also have a rotation of Hazy Little Thing from Sierra Nevada Brewing. Its juicy hops and silky malt meet in a 'Hazy Little Thing' with fruit-forward flavor, modest bitterness, and a smooth finish.
